

**Moreno Valley Animal Services
Summary Report – August 2024
Public Safety Sub Committee Meeting
September 17, 2024**

A. Shelter Services:

The following illustrates the number of positive outcomes of shelter pets during the month of August 2024 (family adoptions, pets rescued, reclaimed by their owners, TNR program, and pets transferred to pet adoption centers).

The Animal Rescue Coordinator helped perform temperament testing on 60 dogs and transferred the following pets with medical or special needs to our rescue partners:

1 Terrier	Senior dog 12 years+

In addition, the Animal Rescue Coordinator transferred 1 desert tortoise to a non-profit wildlife animal rescue organization.

B. Field Services:

Field Services operates on a 7-day, 24-hour calls for service model based on the level of priority on all calls received. Six full-time Animal Control Officers (ACOs), one full-time and one part-time Animal License Inspectors, reporting to one Field Services Supervisor currently serve the city. ACOs rotate Night Truck assignment in response to high priority calls after hours. During normal business hours, Animal Control Officers respond to routine and high priority service requests.

C. Other Activities

- “Clear the Shelters” & “Dog Days of Summer” Pet Adoption Events:
112 pets found new homes during these two adoption events beginning August 10th through August 31st at the Animal Shelter. Adoption fees, \$50 for dogs and \$25 for cats, included spay-neuter, vaccinations, a HomeAgain microchip, and pet care products for each adopted pet.
- FREE HomeAgain Microchips:
During the month of August, a total of 70 Moreno Valley pets received a free HomeAgain microchip. This initiative will continue throughout the month of September 2024.

D. Upcoming Events

The following special adoption events are scheduled this fall at the Moreno Valley Animal Shelter:

- FREE Microchips – During the entire month of September 2024 microchips will be provided free to Moreno Valley resident’s pets by Animal Shelter staff. To qualify you must be a Moreno Valley resident, and up to 4 pets can be chipped. No appointment is necessary.
- “Home 4 The Holidays” Pet Adoption Event – October 15th – October 19th. Dog adoptions \$50.00 for dogs; all cats \$15.00. Fees include spay-neuter, vaccinations, and a HomeAgain microchip.
