To maintain critical Moreno Valley services, including 9-1-1 response times, robbery/burglary prevention, neighborhood police patrols/fire service levels; address homelessness; repair streets/potholes; keep	
public areas safe/clean; help retain businesses; and for general government use, shall the measure establishing a locally-controlled 1¢ transaction and use (sales) tax, first enacted by local voters in 2021, generating approximately \$30,000,000 annually until ended by voters, with audits/spending disclosure, be adopted? The polls will be open between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.

Arguments:

The last day to submit primary arguments in favor or against the measure is August 19, 2024, no later than 5:30 p.m. No primary argument may exceed 300 words. No more than five signatures shall appear with any primary arguments. Authors of the Argument form shall accompany all primary arguments. There will be a 10-day public examination period for primary arguments from August 20, 2024, through August 29, 2024.

The last day for the same authors of the primary arguments to file rebuttals is August 29, 2024, no later than 5:30 p.m. Rebuttals are limited to 250 words. Statement of Authors of Arguments form must be attached to the rebuttal. There will be a 10-day public examination period for rebuttals from August 30, 2024, through September 8, 2024.
